Fiscal Year: FY 2026 Spend Plan

Purpose: Provides funding to support programs and projects that work to prevent incidents of family violence, domestic violence, and dating violence and to provide immediate shelter and supportive services for adult and youth survivors of domestic violence (and their dependents).

Coalitions	\$20,350,000	Continuation	Coordinate state- and territory-wide improvements within local communities, social service systems, and programming regarding the prevention and intervention of domestic violence.
Specialized Services for Abused Parents and Children (SSAPC) Demonstration	\$24,500,000	New	These SSAPC demonstration projects will focus on expanding their capacity (as family violence, domestic violence, and dating violence coalitions; local programs; tribal communities; and community-based programs) to prevent future domestic violence by addressing, in a developmentally appropriate manner, the needs of children exposed to family violence, domestic violence, or dating violence.
National Resource Training and Technical Assistance Centers	\$12,210,000	New	Provide a wide range of free, comprehensive and individualized technical assistance, training and resource materials. The scope of NRCDDV's technical assistance is broad and includes domestic violence intervention and prevention, community education and organizing, public policy and systems advocacy, and funding.
Culturally Specific Grants	\$7,500,000	New	Culturally specific organizations and programs to provide trauma-informed, developmentally sensitive and culturally relevant services for children, individuals, and families affected by sexual assault and domestic violence from racial/ethnic specific populations, underserved communities, and historically marginalized communities across the nation.
